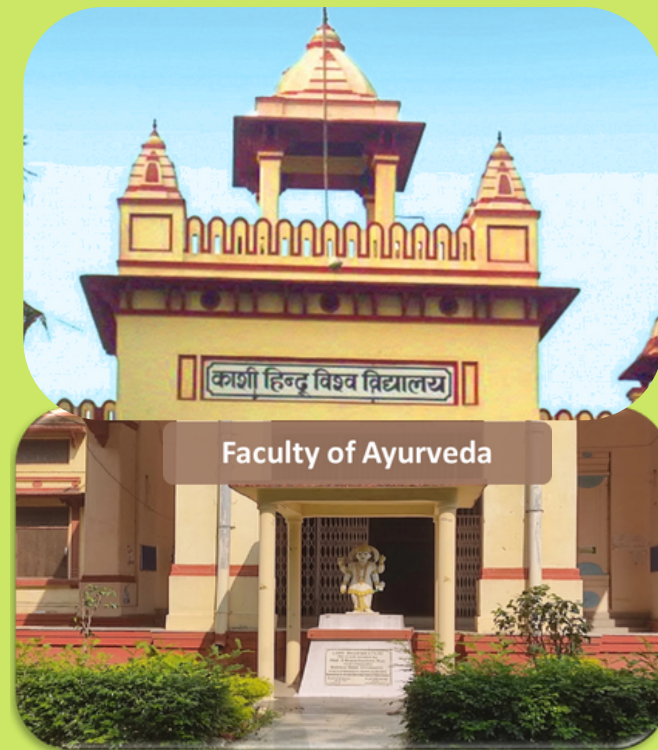

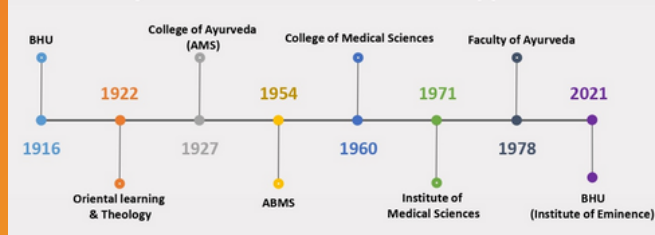

Under the leadership of the esteemed visionary Bharat Ratna Mahamana Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya, the Banaras Hindu University was established in 1916 through an Act of Parliament. Ayurveda became an integral part of education at Banaras Hindu University under the Faculty of Oriental Learning in the year 1922 as a subject and in 1923 as a dedicated Department of Ayurveda.

Ayurveda in BHU – Timeline Recapped



Currently, the Faculty of Ayurveda has 17 departments, more than 100 teachers and offers UG, PG, PhD as well as various certificate/diploma courses, Library and hostel facilities, Ayurvedic Pharmacy and Dispensary, Medicinal Plant Garden, Herbarium, Raw drug museum for herbs, minerals and metals, for quality teaching and research. We embrace a unique ecosystem of integrative education, interdisciplinary academia, research collaboration, and clinical health services [Sir Sunderlal Hospital, BHU (1200 bedded), with Ayurveda and Modern Medicine services under one roof], which rarely exist in other parts of the country.

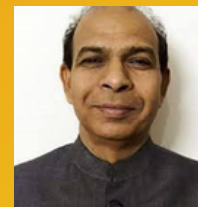
